

Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation Study on Obsessive Compulsive Disorder



Researchers at the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) are conducting a study that evaluates cortical inhibition in Obsessive Compulsive Disorder patients and their family members using transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS).

Inclusion Criteria

- Between the ages of 18 to 65
- Are unmedicated or medicated
- Have had no increase or initiation of new medications for 4 weeks prior to screening
- Have at least one unaffected family member (biological parents and/or full siblings)

Interview & Questionnaires: You will be asked to undergo an interview and to complete questionnaires which assess your symptoms and mood.

Urine Sample: You will be asked to provide a urine sample to screen for drugs.

Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI): A scan of your brain will be taken using an MRI.

Cortical Inhibition (CI): We will measure CI using TMS alone and TMS combined with Electroencephalography (EEG).
